# **TECHNICAL RULES**

## **1 RULES AND REGULATION**

- 1.1 The Diving competitions shall be carried out in accordance with the Federation Internationale de Natation (FINA) Rules. In the case of any controversy over the interpretation of rules, the English version of the FINA rules (2015-2017) shall be considered binding. Issues not stipulated for shall be dealt with according to the following.
- 1.2 For technical matters, the FINA Rules are binding. For general matters, ISG Basic regulations, General Rules and this Technical Handbook should be consulted.
- 1.3 The competition area and all equipment will be presented in accordance with the FINA rules and regulations.

## **2 VENUE AND SCHEDULE**

- 2.1 The Diving competition shall be organized in Baku with competition being staged in the Baku Aquatics Centre.
- 2.2 All training will take place at the Baku Aquatics Centre.
- 2.3 The Diving competitions will be organized in a 20-meter length X 25-meter-wide pool complete with 3m springboards, two 1m springboards, 10m platform.

## **3 TECHNICAL MEETING**

- 3.1 The technical meeting shall be held on one day prior to competition.  
The meeting shall be attended by:
  - FINA Technical Delegates (Commission+ 3 TDC Members)
  - FINA Referee/s
  - Team representatives (Team delegate, coach, judge)
- 3.2 The meeting aims at providing the necessary information on the progress of events as well as the explanations related to the implementation of the Rules of the International Federation and the provisions of the sport Technical Regulations.
- 3.3 The competition draw will take place during the Technical Meeting.

## **4 EVENTS AND PARTICIPATION**

- 4.1 A National Olympic Committee whose National Federation is a member of Federation Internationale de Natation (FINA) is entitled to participate in competition with one team composed of 12 divers (6 men and 6 women), one (1) team manager, two (2) coaches and one (1) Paramedic.
- 4.2 A diver is entitled to participate in individual and team synchronised competitions.
- 4.3 Each NOC is permitted two entries per individual event and one entry for the synchronised event.
- 4.4 Athletes must be born before 1 May 2003

#### 4.5 Medal Events and Quota:

## 5 COMPETITION FORMAT

### 5.1 Individual Events.

- 5.1.1 All individual events shall consist of a preliminary phase and final phase.
- 5.1.2 The order of diving shall be determined by random draw. This draw will take place at the Technical Meeting
- 5.1.3 The 12 athletes with the highest scores in the preliminary phase will progress to the final. In the final the divers will compete in reverse order of their ranking determined by the total scores at the end of the preliminary phase.
- 5.1.4 All individual competitions for men shall comprise six (6) dives. All individual competitions for women shall comprise five (5) dives.

### 5.2 Synchronised events

- 5.2.1 All synchronised events will consist of a final phase only.
- 5.2.2 The order of diving shall be determined by random draw. This draw will take place at the Technical Meeting.
- 5.2.3 All synchronised competitions for men shall comprise six (6) dives. All synchronised competitions for women shall comprise five (5) dives.

## 6 APPAREL

- 6.1 Participants should wear sports apparel in compliance with the FINA Rules.

## 7 MEDALS, DIPLOMAS, AND VICTORY CEREMONIES

- 7.1 Victory ceremonies shall be held directly at the end of each competition. Winning athletes shall wear the sport uniform (e.g. warm up tracksuit) or the official uniform of their NOC.
- 7.2 Winners in Diving competitions shall be awarded the following prizes and diplomas:
  - Individual and synchronised events:
    - The first place: A gold medal and a diploma.
    - The second place: A silver medal and a diploma.
    - The third place: A bronze medal and a diploma.
    - Places from fourth (4th) to eighth (8th) shall be awarded ranking certificates.
