# TECHNICAL RULES

## 1 RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1.1 The 4<sup>th</sup> Islamic Solidarity Games Shooting Competition will be conducted according to the International Shooting Sport Federation Rules and Regulations that will be in force at the time of the Games.
- 1.2 Juries (Jury of Appeal, Competition Jury, Classification Jury, and Equipment Control Jury) will be designated by the International Shooting Sport Federation to supervise the competition. Qualified Range Officers / Referees holding applicable International Shooting Sport Federation licenses will conduct the competitions.

## 2 COMPETITION MANAGEMENT

- 2.1 Competitions shall be organized by AISGOC, in alignment with ISSF Rules and under the supervision of the Technical Committee.
- 2.2 The Technical Delegates and Jury members shall be appointed by the International Shooting Sport Federation.
- 2.3 The Azerbaijan Shooting Federation shall support the appointment of the National Technical Officials, who shall be approved by the International Shooting Sport Federation.

## 3 VENUE AND SCHEDULE

- 3.1 The Shooting competition shall be organized during the period 13<sup>th</sup> – 17<sup>th</sup> May 2017. The Shooting competitions shall be staged in Baku Shooting Centre.
- 3.2 Training for participating teams will also be staged at Baku Shooting Centre according to a schedule made by the Organizing Committee and distributed to the teams participating in the Games.

## 4 EVENTS AND PARTICIPATION

4.1 The Shooting competition will be held in the following individual and team events:

4.2 SHOTGUN events. NOC's may enter a maximum of three (3) athletes per individual shotgun events.

4.3 RIFLE / PISTOL events. NOC's may enter a maximum of three (3) athletes per individual events.

4.4 One (1) men's athlete and one (1) women's athlete from the same country, who participated in individual events, may also participate as one team in the separate Trap, Skeet, Air 50 Pistol, and Air 50 Rifle Mixed team events.

#### 4.8 International Shooting Sport Federation ID Number

All athletes must sign an "Athlete's Declaration" and have an official International Shooting Sport Federation ID number issued before participation in the competition.

4.9 Athletes without International Shooting Sport Federation ID numbers will not be allowed to participate. International Shooting Sport Federation ID numbers can be obtained from the International Shooting Sport Federation Headquarters by using the official application form.

## 5 COMPETITION SCHEDULE

5.1 The following key dates are below as well as the provisional competition schedule. Please note this is subject to change and will not be confirmed, nor the training schedule confirmed, until closer to the event.

## 6 SHOOTING RANGE INFORMATION

6.1 Shooting events of the Islamic Solidarity Games will take place at the Baku Olympic Shooting Range. The venue was built in 2015 for the 1<sup>st</sup> European Games. The Range is situated at 15 km and 20 minutes driving distance from the Athletes village.

## 6.2 Rifle/Pistol

The shooting range is equipped as follows:

Range	Description
50m range	80 firing points, electronic targets, SIUS AG
25m range	50 firing points (10 groups); electronic targets, SIUS AG
10m hall	80 firing points, electronic targets, SIUS AG
Finals hall	10 firing points, electronic targets, SIUS AG

The firing direction of the 50m and 25m range is north.

## 6.3 Shotgun

6.3.1 The shooting range has 5 combined ranges for Trap/Double Trap/Skeet.

6.3.2 The shooting range is equipped with Matarelli machines and Elettronica Progetti acoustic release system. The Skeet ranges operate with acoustic release system.

6.3.3 All ranges are equipped with Elettronica Progetti electronic scoreboards.

6.3.4 The firing direction of the shooting range is north.

# 7 IMMIGRATION AND CUSTOMS REQUIREMENTS

## 7.1 Gun License

All athletes must declare all the firearms and ammunition to be brought into Azerbaijan and return to the Organizing Committee the Firearm and Ammunition Form no later than 1 April 2017. A group application may be made where the team or group will be arriving and departing together, but each individual competitor and firearms must be listed within the application. An individual application is required if an athlete will be entering Azerbaijan independently of any team or group arrival.

## 7.2 Ammunition

Assistance of customs formalities will be provided by the Organizing Committee upon arrival. The custom authorities will allow all participating athletes to import with them all the necessary ammunition that will be used for the competition, however for the convenience of the shotgun athletes, different types of well-known brands will be available for sale at the shooting range at approximately EUR 8.00 – 12.00 per box.

## 7.3 Port of Entry

Official port of entry for the Games is Baku airport. All firearms will be taken from the athletes at the airport and delivered by secure transportation directly to the Armoury at the competition venue (Baku Olympic Shooting Centre).

Further details on arrivals processes will follow in due course.

## **8 COMPETITION RELATED PROCEDURES AT THE SHOOTING RANGE**

### **8.1 Technical Meeting**

The Technical Meeting will take place on 12 May 2017, at the Finals Hall.

Each participating NOC should have at least one representative present at the Technical Meeting to receive updated information regarding Final Competition Schedule (including Training Schedule) and draw procedures.

### **8.2 Storage of Firearms and Ammunition**

According to the Azerbaijan law, all firearms and ammunition will be stored at the shooting range and athletes will not be allowed to take any firearms and ammunition out of the Baku Olympic Shooting Range.

### **8.3 Ammunition**

Different types of well-known shotgun ammunition brands will be available for sale at the shooting range at approximately EUR 8.00 – 12.00 per box of 25.

## **9 CEREMONIES**

9.1 The Victory Ceremonies will take place at the shooting range at the end of each competition day.

9.2 During the ceremonies the athletes are required to present themselves in their official national uniform or national tracksuits (tops and bottoms) and observe the required ISSF protocols.

9.3 First Place: A Gold medal and a diploma for each team member.

Second Place: A Silver medal and a diploma for each team member.

Third Place: A Bronze medal and a diploma for each team member.

Places from fourth (4th) to eighth (8th) shall be awarded ranking certificates.
