## **TECHNICAL RULES**

### **1 COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 1.1 The 4<sup>th</sup> Islamic Solidarity Games Basketball 3x3 competition shall be carried out in accordance with the FIBA 3x3 Official Rules of the Game.
- 1.2 For technical matters, the FIBA 3x3 Rules are binding, for general matters, ISG Basic regulations, General Rules and this Technical Handbook should be consulted.

### **2 COMPETITION MANAGEMENT**

- 2.1 Competitions shall, under the authority of the ISSF, be organized by AISGOC, in conformity with FIBA 3x3 Rules and under the supervision of the Technical Committee.
- 2.2 The Technical Delegate shall be appointed by FIBA.
- 2.3 The Azerbaijan Basketball Federation shall support the appointment of the National Technical Officials, who shall be approved by the Technical Delegate.

### **3 VENUE AND SCHEDULE**

- 3.1 The Basketball 3x3 competition shall be organized during the period 16<sup>th</sup> – 19<sup>th</sup> May 2017.
- 3.2 The Basketball 3x3 competition shall be staged at Baku Basketball Arena.
- 3.3 Training facilities will be prepared for the participating teams according to a schedule made by the Organizing Committee and distributed to the teams participating in the Games.

### **4 TECHNICAL MEETING**

- 4.1 The Technical Meeting will be held one (1) day before the start of competition, to coordinate the events of the tournament presided by the Competition Manager and Technical Delegate. The time and venue of the meeting will be confirmed in due course.

### **5 EVENTS AND PARTICIPATION**

- 5.1 The Basketball 3x3 competitions shall be organized with a maximum of twelve (12) participating teams, in both Men's and Women's Basketball 3x3, including the Host Country team.
- 5.2 An NOC whose National Federation is a member of the International Basketball Federation (FIBA), is entitled to enter a Men's team and a Women's team.
- 5.3 If the countries wishing to participate exceed the maximum of 16, the selection will be based on FIBA 3x3 world rankings.
- 5.4 Eligibility of Players
  - a. A player must be the Nationality of the NOC he/she represents.
  - b. A player must be registered in FIBA's 3x3planet.com with a confirmed account.
  - c. Athlete Passports will be inspected as proof of eligibility before the start of competition.
- 5.5 Men's and women's teams are each composed of four (4) players and one (1) team leader.

- 5.6 An NOC who enters teams in both the men's and women's competitions, and is successful in securing a team place for one of those competitions, is not automatically awarded a team place in the other competition. Men's and Women's Team places are considered independent from each other.

## **6 COMPETITION FORMAT**

- 6.1 The competition is organized with maximum twelve (12) teams in both men's and women's competitions, and shall play as follows:

### **Preliminaries**

Teams shall be divided into four (4) groups of three (3) teams. Inside the group each team shall play against the others in a one round tournament to determine the preliminary ranking.

### **Quarter Finals**

The top 2 teams in each group shall play on knockout basis in the following order:

Men:	Women:
1.A1 vs. D2	A1 vs. D2
2.A2 vs. D1	A2 vs. D1
3.B1 vs. C2	B1 vs. C2
4.B2 vs. C1	B2 vs. C1

### **Semi Final**

- 1.Winner 1 Vs Winner 2
- 2.Winner 3 Vs Winner 4

### **Finals**

Winners of the semi-finals shall qualify for the gold medal match and losing teams shall qualify for the bronze medal match.

- 6.2 In addition to the competition medal events an informal shoot out competition will be arranged per FIBA rules. Details will be confirmed at the technical meeting.

## **7 COMPETITION SCHEDULE**

- 7.1 A competition schedule will be developed closer to the event. Outline dates of competition are 16<sup>th</sup> – 19<sup>th</sup> May 2017.

## **8 APPAREL**

- 8.1 Every team shall abide by the FIBA 3x3 rules regarding the competition uniform.

## **9 EQUIPMENT**

- 9.1 The playing court, the supplies and equipment of the game must comply with the specifications and standards stipulated in the FIBA 3X3 Official Rules of the Game.
- 9.2 The official 3X3 ball shall be used in competition in line with FIBA specifications.

## **10 MEDALS, DIPLOMAS AND VICTORY CEREMONIES**

- 10.1 Victory ceremonies shall be held directly at the end of each competition. Winner athletes shall wear the sport uniform or the official uniform of their NOC.
- 10.2 Winners in Basketball 3X3 competitions shall be awarded the following prizes and diplomas:
- The first place: A gold medal and a diploma for each player
  - The second place: A silver medal and a diploma for each player
  - The third place: A bronze medal and a diploma for each player.
  - Places from fourth (4th) to eighth (8th) shall be awarded ranking certificates.
