TECHNICAL RULES

1 RULES AND REGULATION

- 1.1 The competition will be conducted in accordance with the latest UWW and Organization Rules, UWW Refereeing Rules and UWW Anti-Doping Rules.
- 1.2 For technical matters, the IWUF Rules are binding. For general matters, ISG Regulations, General Rules and this Technical Handbook should be consulted.

2 COMPETITION MANAGEMENT

- 2.1 Competitions shall, under the authority of the ISSF, be organized by AISGOC, in conformity with UWW Rules and under the supervision of the Technical Committee.
- 2.2 The Technical Delegate shall be appointed by UWW.
- 2.3 The Azerbaijan Wrestling Federation shall support the appointment of the National Technical Officials, who shall be approved by the Technical Delegate.

3 VENUE AND SCHEDULE

- 3.1 Wrestling competition shall be organized during the period from 17th 22nd May 2017.
- 3.2 Wrestling competitions shall be staged in Heydar Aliyev Arena, Baku, Azerbaijan.
- 3.3 Training venues have been prepared for the participating teams according to a schedule made by the Organizing Committee and distributed to the teams participating in the Games.

4 TECHNICAL MEETING

- 4.1 The technical meeting shall be held on 16th May 2017. The meeting shall be attended by:
 - Technical Delegate
 - Representatives of the Refereeing Committee and referees.
 - Two members of each participating team (Official and Coach).
- 4.2 Proceedings shall follow the Agenda of the meeting. The meeting aims at providing the necessary information on the progress of events as well as the explanations related to the implementation of the Rules of the UWW and the provision of the sport Technical Regulations.

5 EVENTS AND PARTICIPATION

- 5.1 Each National Olympic Committee (NOC) has the right to participate with a maximum of one (1) wrestler per weight category in all styles (Greco-Roman, women and freestyle). The maximum number of athletes per delegation is 24.
- 5.2 Events are as follows:

- 5.3 All competitors must be of senior age (born 31 December 1998 or earlier). The age will be verified with the wrestlers' individual passports. The age category of participants is determined according to UWW Regulations. Wrestlers born 1999 must present a medical certificate justifying the reason for wrestling in a higher age group. Wrestlers are under the entire responsibility of their National Federation.
- 5.4 All wrestlers must be in possession of a valid license purchased beforehand from UWW.
- 5.5 The Composition of the official delegation will be in according to the following table as laid down by UWW.

6 **COMPETITION FORMAT**

- 6.1 The competitions take place by direct elimination system with an ideal number of wrestlers, i.e. 4, 8, 16, 32, 64, etc. If there is no ideal number of wrestlers in a category, qualification matches will take place. Pairing is made in the order of the numbers drawn at random.
- 6.2 All wrestlers who lost against both finalists will have repechage matches. There are two separated groups of repechage: one group of wrestlers who lost against the first finalist, and another group of wrestlers who lost against the second finalist. The repechage matches begin with wrestlers who lost in the first round including in matches to obtain the ideal number against one of the two finalists up to the losers in the semi-finals by direct elimination.
- 6.3 The winners of the two repechage groups will receive each the bronze medal.
- 6.4 Each weight category begins and ends in a day. Each category weigh-in and medical control take place the day before the beginning of the category concerned.
- 6.5 The competition takes place in the following manner:
 - Qualification rounds
 - Elimination rounds
 - Repechage rounds
 - Finals

 - The first place: a gold medal and diplomas
 - The second place: a silver medal and diplomas
 - The third place: two bronze medals and diplomas
