### **TECHNICAL RULES**

#### 1 COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1.1 The Wushu competition at the 4<sup>th</sup> Islamic Solidarity Games, Baku 2017 shall be conducted in accordance with the latest International Wushu Federation (IWUF) Rules. In the case of any controversy over the interpretation of rules, the Chinese version of the IWUF rules shall be considered binding. Issues that are not covered shall be dealt with according to the following.
- 1.2 For technical matters, the IWUF Rules are binding.
- 1.3 For general matters, ISG Basic regulations, General Rules, and this Technical Handbook should be consulted

#### 2 COMPETITION MANAGEMENT

- 2.1 Competitions shall, under the authority of the ISSF, be organized by AISGOC, in conformity with IWUF Rules and under the supervision of the Technical Committee.
- 2.2 Mr Byron Jacobs is appointed by the IWUF the Technical Delegate for Wushu Competition at the 4<sup>th</sup> Islamic Solidarity Games.
- 2.3 The Azerbaijan Wushu Federation shall support the appointment of the National Technical Officials, who shall be approved by the Technical Delegate.

#### 3 COMPETITION AND TRAINING VENUES

- 3.1 The Wushu competition will be held on 20<sup>th</sup>-23<sup>rd</sup> May, 2017 at Baku Sport Hall, Baku, Azerbaijan.
- 3.2 Training venue will be prepared for the participating teams according to a schedule made by the Organizing Committee and distributed to the teams participating in the Games.

#### 4 TECHNICAL MEETING AND DRAW

- 4.1 The Technical Meeting shall be held one day prior to competition on May 19<sup>th</sup>, 2017 in Athletes Village. The meeting shall be attended by:
  - IWUF staff: Technical Delegate, Technical Official Group (Jury & Appeal Commission)
  - Representatives of the Sport Referees and Judges' Committee
  - Two Representative of each team (official and/or coach).
- 4.2 The meeting aims at providing the necessary information on the progress of events as well as the explanations related to the implementation of the Rules of the International Wushu Federation and the provisions of the Wushu Technical Regulations.
- 4.3 The draw will be conducted by the Technical Committee after Technical Meeting. Each team may send two representatives to attend the ceremony. The ceremony will start from the lighter weight categories.

#### 5 EVENTS AND PARTICIPATION

- 5.1 Every official & provisional Member Federation/Association of IWUF and ISSF is qualified to participate in the competition.
- 5.2 The Senior Men's Sanda events will be as follows:

5.3 Each NOC may enter a maximum of six (6) athletes across all Sanda weight categories with a maximum of one (1) athlete per weight category and following delegation:

- 5.4 The competitor must produce a personal insurance certificate.
- 5.5 The competitor must produce a health certificate showing his electroencephalogram (EEG), electrocardiogram (ECG), blood pressure and heart rate in a medical check-up taken within 20 days before his registration.
- 5.6 All athletes participating in Wushu must be born on / or before 10th May 1999

#### **6 COMPETITION FORMAT**

6.1 The Knock-Out system will be adopted in Sanda competition. If the number of competitors within a single weight division is less than 4, a single round robin system will be adopted.

#### 7 COMPETITION SCHEDULE

7.1 A detailed competition schedule version will be issued closer to the event.

#### **8 EQUIPMENT**

8.1 The Organizing Committee shall provide the competitions equipment (head guard, gloves, body protector, groin guard) in accordance with the IWUF Rules. Athletes should provide their own 2 set of uniform (red and blue).

#### 9 APPAREL

- 9.1 Competitors' wear and protective gear shall be either red or blue.
- 9.2 Competitors shall wear shirts and trunks in the same colour as their protective gear.

#### 10 MEDALS, DIPLOMAS, AND VICTORY CEREMONIES

- 10.1 Victory ceremonies shall be held directly following the end of each Competition final. Winners shall wear their official Apparel of their National Olympic Committees.
- 10.2 Medals will be awarded on the following basis:
  - First placed gold medal
  - Second placed silver medal
  - Third placed (juxtaposition) Bronze medal
