C. ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

All athletes must comply with the provisions of the Olympic Charter currently in force, including but not limited to, Rule 41 (Nationality of Competitors). Only those athletes who have complied with the Olympic Charter may participate in the Youth Olympic Games.

Age

To be eligible to participate in the Youth Olympic Games, athletes must have been born between 1 January 2002 and 31 December 2003.

Additional IF requirement:

To be eligible to participate in the Youth Olympic Games, athletes must attend the YOG Canoe World Qualification Event.





D. QUALIFICATION PATHWAY

Each of the 64 athletes that qualify for the YOG must compete in both Sprint and Slalom events in that category (C1 or K1) or will be disqualified from all competitions.

An athlete once selected for the YOG in Canoeing can participate in both categories (i.e. Canoe and Kayak), subject to technical standards as approved by the Chief Judge, regardless if the NOC is already represented in that category.

HOST COUNTRY PLACES

The host country will automatically qualify one (1) male and one (1) female athlete, on the condition that the athletes meet the eligibility requirements described under section C.





UNIVERSALITY PLACES

Two (2) male Universality Places and two (2) female Universality Places will be made available to eligible NOCs at the YOG, subject to the athletes meeting the required technical level and the eligibility criteria defined under section C.

The International Olympic Committee will invite all eligible NOCs to submit their requests for Universality Places by 15 January 2017. The Tripartite Commission will confirm, in writing, the allocation of invitation places to the relevant NOCs, in collaboration with ICF, as of 13 March 2017. The NOCs will have until 31 March 2017 to confirm the use of their places to the Tripartite Commission.

E. CONFIRMATION PROCESS FOR QUOTA PLACES

CONFIRMATION OF QUALIFICATION PLACES

The ICF will confirm all qualification places to NOCs no later than two (2) weeks after the completion of the YOG Canoeing World Qualification Event on their website at www.canoeicf.com

The NOCs will then have two (2) weeks to confirm to ICF and BAYOGOC if they wish to use the quota places, as detailed in section G. Qualification Timeline.

CONFIRMATION OF HOST COUNTRY PLACES

The host country must confirm to the ICF and BAYOGOC by no later than two (2) weeks after the completion of the YOG Canoeing World Qualification the participation of its athletes.

F. REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUOTA PLACES

REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUALIFICATION PLACES

Should an NOC decline, or not be able to use an allocated quota place, the place will be reallocated to the next best ranked NOC not yet qualified in the respective event at the YOG Canoeing World Qualifying Event taking into account any continental restrictions outlined in section D.

Should the list of NOCs be exhausted in the respective event, the place will be reallocated to the next best ranked NOC in the same gender not yet qualified at the YOG Canoeing World Qualifying Event in the four (4) events. Should the list of NOCs still be exhausted, the place will be reallocated to the next best ranked NOC in the original category (C1 or K1) not yet qualified at the YOG Canoeing World Qualifying Event, regardless of gender.

REALLOCATION OF UNUSED HOST COUNTRY PLACES

Should the host country qualify through the YOG Canoeing World Qualifying Event, or should the host country be unable to fulfil the conditions mentioned above, then the places will be reallocated to the next highest ranked NOC from Americas not already qualified in that category from the YOG Canoeing World Qualifying Event.





Should there be no NOCs from the Americas able to use this quota place, the place will be reallocated to the next best ranked NOC not yet qualified in the respective category at the YOG Canoeing World Qualifying Event regardless of the continent.

REALLOCATION OF UNUSED UNIVERSALITY PLACES

Any unused Universality Places, including those returned after the final allocation by the YOG Tripartite Commission will be reallocated by the ICF using the results of the YOG Canoeing World Qualifying Event. The place(s) will be reallocated to the next best ranked NOC(s) not yet qualified in Canoeing across all continents.
